## A BILL

To amend the Public Health Service Act to authorize the Health Resources and Services Administration to carry out the following activities with respect to autism spectrum disorder (referred to in this section as "ASD"), and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. AUTISM ACTIVITIES OF HRSA.
- 4 Part R of title III of the Public Health Service Act
- 5 (42 U.S.C. 280i et seq.) is amended—

1	(1) by redesignating section 399EE as section
2	399FF; and
3	(2) by inserting after section 399DD the fol-
4	lowing new section:
5	"SEC. 399EE. AUTISM ACTIVITIES OF HEALTH RESOURCES
6	AND SERVICES ADMINISTRATION.
7	"(a) In General.—The Administrator of the Health
8	Resources and Services Administration shall carry out the
9	following activities with respect to autism spectrum dis-
10	order (referred to in this section as 'ASD'):
11	"(1) Developing and disseminating to all health
12	care providers a multi-disciplinary medical manage-
13	ment model for the diagnosis and care management
14	of individuals with ASD. Such model shall incor-
15	porate and expand upon any existing psychiatric
16	model of the Health Resources and Services Admin-
17	istration.
18	"(2) Conducting research with the objective of

20	training materials with respect to a treatment life

14	"(b) BIENNIAL REPORTS TO CONGRESS.—Not later

19	oping or improving ASD medical treatment plans and
